

International students, we want your political opinion! If you could vote in the US presidential election, how would you vote? On November 4th, between 10am and 6pm, come to the H street terrace at the exit from the Marvin Center Food Court and cast your mock ballot!

You have the opportunity to cast a ballot in a mock election organized especially for the international students at GW. We want to estimate how engaged international students are in this presidential election, and what their opinion is.

We are the voting research group at the Department of Computer Science in the School of Engineering and Applied Sciences. We want to test our latest implementation of a voting system that allows each voter to check that his/her ballot was indeed counted as intended, \*without\* revealing his or her vote. After you cast your ballot, you will be able to check for yourself if the tally includes your vote. Scantegrity II provides a level of universal verifiability and privacy unseen in any other voting system used in public elections.

Remember: on November 4th, between 10am and 6pm, come to the H street terrace of Marvin Center to cast a mock ballot. No registration needed, just show up, mark your ballots and make sure we have counted your vote correctly.
